The Superintendent, as Chief Executive Officer, is accountable to the Board of Directors and is responsible for supporting the Board in its governance role and working with the Board, administration and staff in actualizing the goals of the charter and its mandate as a charter school to lead, share and transform.

- Exceptional skills in building positive, trusting relationships of mutual respect and fostering collaborative working relationships within the Connect Charter School community, the Association of Alberta Public Charter Schools and with other colleagues in education locally and provincially;
- Visionary leadership which seeks out and creates new opportunities for students and staff as a leader in a dynamic, innovative school community;
- Expertise in creating and supporting a safe, caring, engaging and inclusive culture within the school;
- Effective management of school operations and resources in a manner that supports the work of the board, school administration and staff in benefiting student learning to the fullest;

## About Connect Charter School

Connect Charter School (formerly Calgary Science School) was established in 1999 and currently has a 15-year charter due for renewal in July 2027. Connect currently serves 620 grade 4 to 9 students who reside in all quadrants of the City of Calgary. Students are accepted on a first-come, first served basis and are drawn from a large waiting list. The goals and guiding principles of the school reflect the strong emphasis on:

- meaningfully engaging students in learning and teaching through a disposition of inquiry;
- appropriately using technology to enhance learning and teaching and demonstrate understanding;
- providing a rich variety of opportunities to learn beyond the classroom and to develop an appreciation for environmental stewardship and learning through outdoor education experiences;
- fostering a high level of learner engagement with a focus on having all students experience success;
- enhancing learning, teaching and leadership through a culture of collaboration within the classroom, throughout the school and with colleagues in education beyond the school; and
- engaging students as researchers and informing teaching and leadership practices through research.

The successful candidate will qualify for an Alberta teaching certificate, hold a Master's degree, and have a minimum of three years experience in a school system in Alberta or in a system of equivalent standard. The duties are carried out on a part-time (approximately 0.6 time) basis.
